Before you can create a live butterfly garden with a profusion of gently floating wings, you need to know a little butterfly biology, including how they survive and reproduce. When designing a butterfly garden, remember that butterflies are not always so attractive. They spend a crucial part of their lives as caterpillars. The caterpillar, or larval, works as the growth period. It can last up to three years in colder climates or as briefly as 12 days in the hottest ones. Bruches eat constantly, pouring their skin four or five times while overcrowding it continuously, like children in the thick of a spurt of growth. Feeding mainly on leaves, balloon caterpillars at a thousand times their initial size by the end of the larval period [source: Dole]. Although caterpillars can eat with abandonment, they are often very demanding. Some species eat only one type of plant. Just like the caterpillar phase is mainly for growth, the adult butterfly phase is mainly for reproduction. Butterflies don't grow. rather than gobble down leaves for growth, butterflies consume mainly nectar for energy to fly. find their food in flower plants called nectar plants. favorite nectar plants tend to be bright and colorful flowers where nectar is easily accessible. single petals flowers with short tubes and wide flat circles are a secure bet; phlox, verbena and flowers in daisies or aster families are usually good choices. The successful butterfly gardens must incorporate a variety of plants both guest and nectar. The skyscraper sunflowers have thick stems and can produce 14 inch flower petals. 2 of 15 Sunforest Mix Girasoli Are you trying to create a sunflower forest? This variety is your best bet. Sunforest Mix sunflowers can grow between 10 to 15 feet tall. When you plant, leave about 3 feet of space between the seeds so that the roots have space to grow. 3 of 15 American giant sunflowers The most popular variety of sunflowers used in growth competitions. American giant sunflowers can grow up to 15 feet tall with faces of about 1 foot wide. Their stems are robust and robust to support the heavy head of the sunflower. 4 of 15 Russian mammoth flowers The height of the Russian sunflowers Mammoth ranges from about 9 to 12 feet in height. These sunflowers are popular with pollinators such as bees and butterflies and animals like birdssquirrels who love to eat their seeds. 5 of 15 Schweinitz flowers One of the rarest types of sunflowers, the Schweinitz sunflowers were named on Lewis David von Schweintz, a botanist who discovered the species in early 1800. They love to grow in packs so you can wait to see 5 to 8 flower faces that bloom from each stem. 9 of 15 Orsacchiotto girasoli The fluffy petals of Teddy Bear sunflowers are what gives this variety its fascinating name.
