After having dedicated the eccentric issue of July Food and Travel of T+L, I came across a perfect literary accompaniment: the debut novel by journalist Richard C. Morais, The Hundred-Foot Journey (Scribner). The title is a bit misleading – this “journey” is actually one of the thousands of miles, which crosses the unlikely rise of an Indian chef, Hassan Haji, from Mumbai to Paris, while we follow it from his humble roots in an Indian family restaurant shrub to its enviable location of one of the most famous French chefs, the acquisition of three ambite Michelin stars. A series of unfortunate accidents and fun cultural mishaps lead our unlikely hero from Mumbai to London to a charming village in France, where his family opens the garish Maison Mumbai with total disdain to the elegant, refined, Michelin-two-starred inn a hundred feet across the street. But after his first dismay over the audacity of his new neighbors, he quickly sees the potential in Haji and caress him from a life of obscreness, afflicting on pots of fat and spices, to give him French training. Although the epicuro process has made my mouth water several times, I have especially savored the vivid depictions of places up to far swollen like Mumbai and Lumière, in France, which add a rich environment to the delicious process. The Morais is distributed its narrative with colors, flavors, sounds, smells and textures to tease all five senses. The Hundred-Foot Journey is not limited to cooking, but to the clash of cultures – and as in the end, exceptional food passes through all the barriers. It is not often a book can be described as sumptuous, but it is precisely this tasty mouthpiece of a novel. I ate everything in a few hours, and, to abuse a cliché final food, I’m hungry more.
