

Nobel and his father, the engineer, have tried for years to invent a method to create controlled detonations of nitroglycerin. after several setbacks in the early 1960s, including an explosion that killed his brother, nobel found a way to mix nitroglycerin into a paste that could be burned with black gunpowder and an explosive cap, called his dynamite invention and expected to sell it to mining companies. It wasn't long before the dynamite was oated as a weapon of war. During his successful career, Nobel contributed to the development of more powerful and deadly weapons, including rockets, cannons and new types of gunpowder. The global nobel empire of dynamite factories and weapons made him one of the richest men of his time, but it was also, irony of fate, a pacifist. Later in his life he had a correspondence with berthä von suttner, leader of the movement for international peace and author of "Lay down your Arms". Perhaps my factories will end the war before your congresses," wrote nobel. "The day when two military bodies can annihilate each other in a second, all civilized nations will return with horror and dissolve their troops." If only nobel predictions were true. The inventor died in 1896 at the age of 63 before being able to witness the horrors of World War I, where his weapons would kill millions of people. A prize for the "More Great Benefit for Humanity" A year before his death, nobel signed his third and final testament, in which he set aside most of his immense heritage - about \$200 million, worth \$176 billion. In its nobel will it has specified the five areas in which the prizes should be awarded: Physical, chemical, physiology or medicine, literature and peace. the prize for peace, wrote the nobel, should go "to the person who has done more or better to promote brotherhood among nations, the abolition or reduction of permanent armies and the institution and promotion of congresses for peace". Nobel has defined the specific Swedish academies and other institutions responsible for choosing the winners "without any consideration for nationality" at the nobel foundation, created in 1900, to process a procedure for appointing and selecting the winners of each year. (if you are curious, the word "laureate" comes from the ancient Greek practice of crowning poets and heroes with bay sprigs, a sacred tree of apollus. Now it is oato mainly to designate the winners of impressive academic awards, such as the nobel awards, but also positions of literary distinction, such as the poet graduate.)sixth category in economic sciences was added inThanks to a donation from the Swedish Central Bank "in memory of Alfred Nobel". It is not technically a Nobel prize (since the funds do not come out of the Nobel's will) but it is commonly referred to as one. How to name someone for a Nobel PrizeFirst, bad news. It is not possible to name yourself for a Nobel Prize. Nobel Prize for the four more technical nobel categories - physical, chemical, medicine and economic sciences - are exclusively with a single invitation. Every prize has its own Committee for the Nobel Prize, which sends requests for appointment to around 3,000 people, all the main academics in the sector and former Nobel recipients. From those hundreds of nominations, each Nobel Committee creates a list of finalists, after consulting experts who are then sent to the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences. The Academy therefore votes with the majority for the winners of Nobel awards in physics, chemistry, physiology or medicine and economic sciences. Decisions are definitive. The other two awards, literature and peace, have slightly different nomination processes. The Literature Committee, for example, sends its invitations for candidates, but other "qualified people" are also welcome to present names for consideration. Qualified persons include professors of literature or linguistic at college and university and presidents of national literary societies. The winner of the literature award is selected by the 18 members of the Swedish Academy, which are all prominent Swedish writers, literary and historical scholars. No invitations nominations is sent for the prize for peace. But this does not mean that no one can appoint anyone. You must be a "qualified appointer" to send names. People who adapt to this account include members of the Hague, government ministers or former Nobel prize winners for peace, but also university professors in fields such as social sciences, law, philosophy and religion EI Directors of Peace Research Institutes. The winner of the Peace Prize. It is chosen by the Norwegians, not in Svedes. In his will, Nobel specified that the Peace Prize would have been selected by a five-person committee chosen by the Norwegian Parliament. That's why the peace prize alone is assigned to an Oslo ceremony, while the rest is given to the ceremonies in Stockholm. The deliberation process for choosing the winners is private (you could say "secret) and the complete lists of candidates and their candidates will tend the public up to 50 years later. Famous Nobel Graduates in sciences include Albert Einstein, Marie Curie (which won twice, once for physics and once chemistry), Max Planck, and James Watson and Francis Crick. The winners of literature include Ernest Hemingway and Toni Morrison. Nelson Mandela, Martin Luther King, Jr., Mother Teresa and Malala Yousafzai have All peace awards. From the beginning, the Nobel laureate got international attention for the Cash Hefty Prize which came with the honor. The first Nobel prizes awarded in 1901 came with cash prizes equivalent to almost \$900,000 each in 2018 U.S. Dollars. While the value of the prize immersed in the middle of the last century made a comeback in the 90s. The Nobel prizes of 2021 are each worth 10 million Swedish KRONA (about \$ 1,165,216). Noipobel will instruct that the award amounts should be equal across the five original categories, which was increased to six in 1968 with the addition of economics. In its statutes, the Nobel Foundation states that two prizes can be awarded in each category each year, with the cash prize equally divided between the two. Up to three people can jointly receive a single Nobel Prize, in which case they divide the prize money by three.In addition to the cash prize, all prizes of the prize receive an 18-carat nobel dozzuola medal and a hand inked walnut diplomas decorated by Swedish and Norwegian Artists and Calligraphers. During Nobel Week at the beginning of December, the winners travel to Stockholm to give lectures and listen to a Nobel Prize concert. The week is rounded off with a special banquet where the King of Sweden introduces the graduates with their prizes. (At the same time, the winner of the Peace Prize gets his prize in Norway from the King of Norway.) Because of the Covid-19 pandemic, the winners of 2021 will receive their medals in their home countries. The criticisms of Nobel Prizes Nobel Prizes are extremely subjective, and every year there are crass rumours that the secret Scandinavian committees have chosen the wrong winners. But beyond the occasional snob, there are some common criticisms and suggestions for how the Nobel Prize could evolve and improve. Enrolled, women have been savagely underrepresented as Nobel Laureates. Of the 603 Nobel laureates awarded between 1901 and 2020, only 58 or 9% went to women. Progress has been made throughout the century. From 1901 to 1960, only 12 women received Nobel prizes. But in the four decades between 1981 and 2020, there were 46 women, 28 of whom won after 2000.Many Researchers argue that the Nobel Foundation should raise the limit to three people on how many people can win. The nature of modern research is based on teams with large international collaborations that become the norm. Critics say Nobel prizes should be awarded to whole teams and not just the few big names at the top. (This is just a problem for science awards. Many organizations, such as the International Committee of the Red Cross, have won the Peace Prize.) A final criticism is that there are simply few categories. When Alfred Nobel created prizes, included fields that involved most of his day, but times changed. where are the categories for mathematics, computer science, biology and genetics or environmental science? if the nobel foundation allowed the addition ofThe sciences of the 1960s, according to some, should add even more fields that represent other areas of great impact of research in the 21st century. Now InterestingAung San Suu Kyi won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1991 for the campaign for democracy in Myanmar. The Nobel rules do not allow it.
