In line with the first fan price policy, these partners agreed not to mark their prices compared to their standalone locations. [61] Other constructions and renovations Trying to address the overcrowding concerns to the entrance and exit areas of the stadium. Overcrowding and congestion were frequent concerns and complaints from fans who participated in important events during the first year of operation of the stadium. Fans participating in the College Football National Championship game reported significant delays in both the entrance and the exit of the stadium, with some waiting times that exceeded 45 minutes to get out of the stadium at the end of the game. [62] Pedestrian bridge A pedestrian bridge was designed but not originally opened when the stadium opened for the first time. The bridge connects the parking spaces of a day of play and the station of Vine City MARTA to the north-west side of the stadium and the courtyard of the house warehouse, allowing pedestrians to avoid crossing the cro to the Super Bowl as it was considered a security risk. Steve Cannon, CEO of AMB Group, [79] said that the sponsorship will last 27 years, calling it the biggest marketing deal in Mercedes-Benz history, but Cannon would not reveal the full value of the deal; However, Sports Business Daily reported in February 2016 that the naming contract wasMercedes-Benz also holds a 10-year naming rights contract for the Louisiana Superdome signed in 2011. [80] [81] The total sales of sponsorship for the Mercedes-Benz Stadium reached \$900 million.
