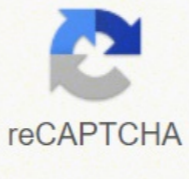

Sometimes they come before an s and sometimes they come after an s. But there is no need to worry because there are some easy ways to differentiate between a singular possessive noun and a plural possessive noun. Unique possessive nouns are easy. For example, in American English, the possessive case can be used with an inanimate object, the cover of the book. However, in British English, the possessive case cannot be used for an inanimate object. Instead, the possession will be displayed with "the cover of the book". " Generally, however, linguists look at forms like education system as compound nouns rather than an adjective + noun form.
