Created by Stan Lee, Ernie Hart and Jack Kirby, the character first appeared in Tales to Astonish #44 (June 1963). It is usually depicted as having the ability to shrink at a height of several centimeters, flying by means of insectoid wings, and blows of bioelectric energy fire. He is a founding member of the Avengers and a long-standing leader of the team. In May 2011, Wasp entered the 99th on the list of the 100 best heroes of comic books of IGN,[1] and 26 on their list of "The Top 50 Avengers" in 2012. He was a founding member of the avengers, appearing in the first issue and giving his name to the team. is with the revengers that janet became more known. At first it was the weak link of the team, but later it became one of the longest active members and acted as team leader for more than anyone beyond america captains. during his absences from the core avengers book, janet appeared in various other publications, including appearances in variousbooks, like Captain America, Iron Man and Fantastic Four. Janet became the leader of the Avengers in The Avengers no. 217 (1982), a position that held until no. 278 (1987), except for a short period in which he passed leadership to the Vision. He appeared in Avengers vol. 3, returning as an active member of the team in question n. 27 (2000) before resuming leadership duties. She and Captain America became the co-leader of the team from number 38. After the events of "Avengers in The Mighty Avengers Bisassembled", Janet appeared in the limited series Oltre! before joining the Avengers in The Mighty Avengers #1 (2007). She was presumed dead during the Secret Invasion events in 2008. Wasp returned to the story of Avengers "End Times" which ran from the number 31 (December 2012) to issue #34 (January 2013). He then appeared as a member of the Uncanny Sales Unit Sales Team and as Wakanda Agent in the title Fresh Start of Avengers. Janet also returned as a romantic interest to Tony Stark in 2018, and left the female lead role of the Iron Man comic two years later, in 2020. Shortly after the resolution of this story, he moves back from leadership, succeeded by Monica Rambeau in that position. After leaving the team, he fights Red Ronin's threat alone. Even though her relationship with Hank Pym remains strong for a while, she refuses her proposal to remarry, saying she would never marry him again. [45] Secret invasion The main article: Secret invasion Janet van Dyne is among the Mighty Avengers heading to New York to face the Skrulls, the real purpose of the serum that the Skrull Hank Pym gave them is revealed. After Queen Veranke is considered dead, the Skrull impostor presses a button that makes Janet quickly increase the size, as well as makes her issue lethal amounts of black-purple energy. Janet realizes that the new particles Pym gave her are turning her into a biobomb, and she tries to escape the battlefield and take as many Skrulls with her as possible when it explodes. To save both the city and the heroes, Thor uses the enchanted hammer Mjolnir to create a space curve to disperse Janet's death, Hank Pym assumes the role of his former wife as Wasp.[47] 2010s Following the Avengers vs. X-Men storyline, it turns out that Janet van Dyne did not die after all, but was restricted in a Microverse by Thorva's space curve. Using its Avengers communication card is able to send a signal with the help of a local called Cru-Sani. Giant-Man, Captain America, Thor and Iron Man go to the Microverse to save it and find it alive and fights against an evil despot, Lord Gouzar, who conquered the Microverse. [48] After a short break, Janet returns to the teama member of the Seller Unit Team. In addition to serving on the roster, it privately finances the team to avoid the problems that would come with the government sponsorship. [49] During the events of Humanity, Janet returns to the Microverse to save a family that has been dragged through a new awakening of Inhuman powers. There he faces Gouzar once again, before returning to normal space. [50] In the battle of the Avengers of Unity with the Knights of Death, the Vespa defeated both Banshee and Sentry resurrected, using both its ability to grow to giant dimensions, and its ability to control the life of insects. [51] After the team is defeated and Earth destroyed, Wasp is the last surviving human and begins a romanticism with Havok (Alex Summers) with whom he has a daughter named Katie. Years later, on Planet X, it is captured when she and Havok destroy a tachyon dam that prevents the journey in time to their era. [61] Powers and abilities Using the mass of its body to be destroyed or obtained from an alternative dimension known as Kosmos. It is able to minimize several centimeters or grow at a maximum of several hundred feet. The smaller or larger dimensions are possible but the effort puts a tension on its body. Initially, these abilities derive from the use of a Pym particle gas released by special capsules, and later the biochemical increase of Henry Pym. Over time, however, its body absorbs enough particles to cause cell mutation due to repeated exposure to Pym particles, allowing it to alter its size at will. At reduced dimensions, its resistance level increases while the mass of its body is compacted. At giant dimensions, its strength and strength increase geometrically with its height, reaching subhuman levels. Despite the advantages of the giant size, Janet usually prefers to remain the Wasp cap, calling its growth power only in times of extreme emergency. At reduced dimensions, the Vespa grows a pair of insect wings translucent from the back, due to genetic modifications by Hank Pym. These give them the power of the flight, at speeds up to 40 mph (64 km/h). The Vespa is able to exploit and increase the natural bioelectric energy of its body, freeing it from its hands in powerful bursts of electric force, which she calls its "sphors of itching", "stingers", or "stings of wax". Originally, it requires special wrist devices to produce these, but once again, the absorption of Pym particles allows it to create unhelped capacity. Wasp genetic modifications also allow her the ability to vent small pregnant antennas from her temples that allowed her to communicate telepathically with and control insects. However, this is a capacity that rarely uses. Van Dyne shows different non-superhuman skills that are used by his particular fame and attention, especially his sense of fashion; in almost all his first appearances, she shows a new costume, supposedly designed and produced alone as a fashion designer equipped. She is also an experienced amateur writer. The wasp is trained in unarmed combat by Captain America and in combat using his special powers by Henry Pym. Moreover, the Vespa is one of the most intuitive, if not deductive, members of the Avengers, and is an expert and strategist leader.
